## **BLACK CHAMBER DAY**

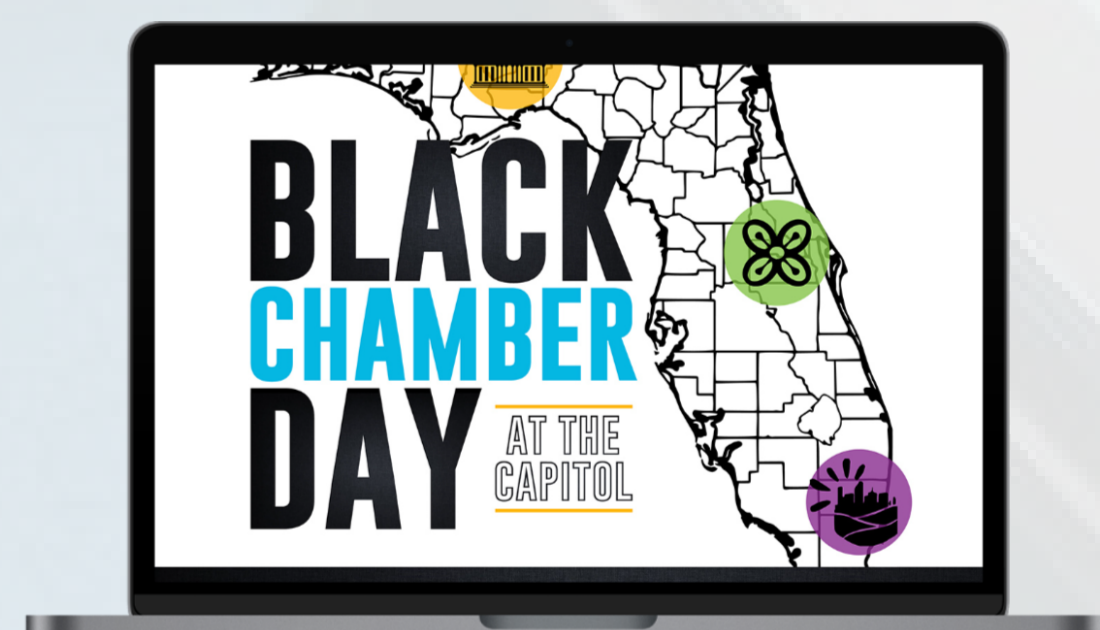
